Event Officials	Judges: WAFSC will work in collaboration with WAISA for local official availability. Interstate/ international judges for any scheduled events are by invitation. Officials: Referee, Technical Controller and/or Technical Specialist and Data Operator/Video Replay Operator for any scheduled events are by invitation. The OC will cover the accommodation and travel cost of invited officials from the 26th September - 1st October 2026.

Membership Requirements	At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant ISA Member/s and an affiliated club. (Inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their ISA Member/s). The membership must be valid during the full competition period. Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.
Insurance/Liability	All members of ISA Member/s are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover. ISA, WAISA & WAFSC assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event. ISA, WAISA & WAFSC recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.
Eligibility to Compete	Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant test level/s at the close of entries.
Practice Sessions	All categories may be offered practices at an additional cost subject to space available. Practice sessions will be OPEN sessions with NO MUSIC to be played

Withdrawals	The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals after the close of entries for any reason. Before close of entries, withdrawals are only possible with a medical certificate provided and a 25% administration fee will be deducted from the refund.

Other Music file notes	All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD (or other device e.g. USB as permitted). Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs & Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction. Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor category, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.
